ISOECOL 2018 – Important dates

- 15 November 2017: First call
- 1 December 2017 — 1 March 2018: Abstract submission
- 1 December 2017: online registration opens
- 30 April 2018: Abstract decisions released
- 31 May 2018: End of early-bird registration
- 30 July — 3 August 2018: IsoEcol meeting

Registration Costs (Chilean pesos)

- Early Bird (before 31 May 2018) regular rate: \$225 000
- Late (after 1 June 2018) regular rate: \$300 000
- Early bird (before 31 May 2018) lower rate : \$125 000
- Late (after 1 June 2018) lower rate: \$160 000

Registration will open 1 December and will be payable (in Chilean pesos CLP) online with credit card. See xe.com for approx. costs in your local currency

Lower rate registration fee extends to student*, low-income economy** and unwaged*** delegates

*Students enrolled on full/part-time degree course (undergraduate, postgraduate) - will need to provide evidence of enrolment on course, a letter of support from supervisor and a letter of application. This letter should provide us with information on why attending the meeting is important for the student, what other funds have been applied for and how it fits with their present/future research plans.
